# KIBO-NO-IE ORPHANGE



KIBO-NO-IE (HOUSE OF HOPE) Orphanage is located on SINJIMA ISLAND near the city of TOKUYAMA and lies forty miles west of MCAS IWAKUNI.

This Squadron began its assistance to Kibo-No-Ie in December of 1961. Thirty-eight of the orphans were brought to the station for a Christmas Party as part of the Station-wide "Operation Happy Face".

Lt. Col. Rieder paid a visit to the orphanage, via helicopter, in January. Work was commenced at this time on leveling an area for the construction of a new dormitory. Due to the location and terrain of Sinjima Island this work must be accomplished by pick, shovel and wheel-barrow. This work was interrupted by a two month deployment to the Philippines but has been continuing since our return.

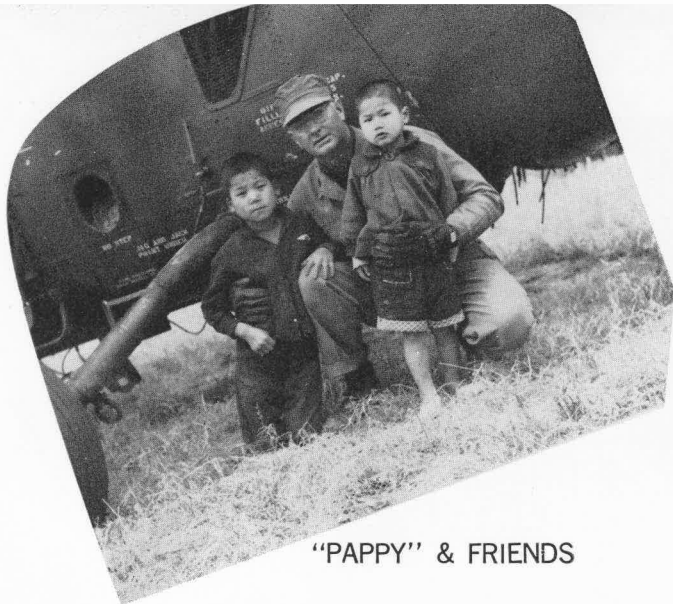
More than a thousand man hours of hard labor and \$700.00 have been contributed by volunteers of this squadron.

Our men, working at the orphanage, have attracted much favorable comment in the Japanese press and on the television networks, thus furthering the People to People program of the Squadron.

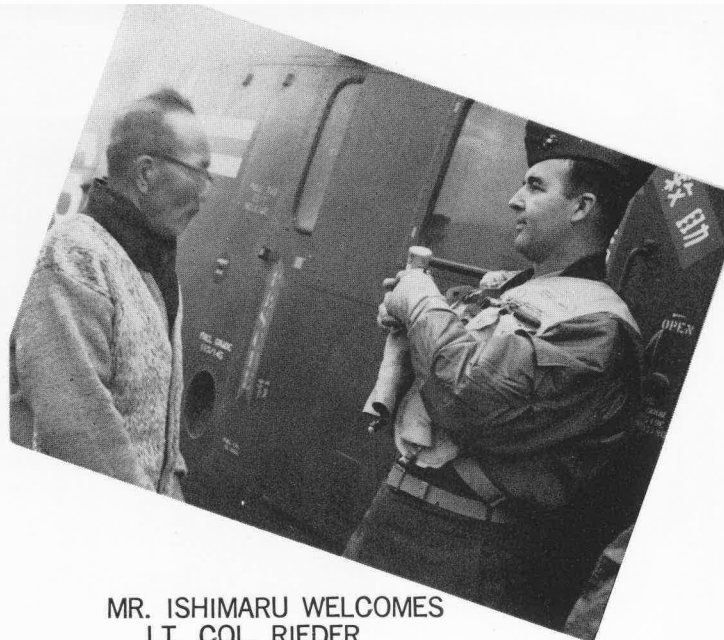
